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LEGISLATION UPDATE

Ms. Sigler stated HB 2304 was the 2% COLA and HB 2485 was the 4% COLA. She noted that the actuary study had returned and OPPRS would remain above 100% funded with either of the COLAs. She mentioned that there had been a desire by the board to change the disability statute so all duty related disabilities would be 100%. Ms. Sigler advised that Rep. David Perryman was planning to introduce language so that any "violent act against a police officer", would result in a 100% In the Line of Duty Disability. She stated there was language regarding Paid Base Salary in the works with Davis Graham & Stubbs. She also mentioned that Rep. Zach Taylor was authoring legislation to adjust the entry wanted to raise the entry age to the system. Ms. Sigler stated they had checked with Davis Graham & Stubbs and there was not issue but OPPRS was not in favor, but felt there might be a need to compromise.
