ASSET CONSULTING GROUP - FINANCIAL CONSULTANT REPORT FOR MONTH ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2022 AND DISCUSSION ON REBALANCING PORTFOLIO ASSETS AMONG VARIOUS ASSET STRATEGIES AND MANAGERS. BOARD TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION AS DEEMED NECESSARY.

Mr. George Tarlas reviewed the ASAP report for the month ended December 31, 2022, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "F". As of December 31, 2022, the total fund was approximately \$2,939.579,000.00. The one-year return net of fees for the total fund is -10.39%.

Mr. Tarlas also advised the board that fees with Blackstone had been renegotiated, for a \$150,000 savings to OPPRS.

- SB ### by Montgomery IRS Technical Cleanup Bill dealing with RMD ages
- HB ### by Ford One time stipend with a minimum of \$1,500 and maximum of \$3,200. She mentioned there would need to be some changes made to this for it to work, such as a safe harbor method as well as OPLLA.
